**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DATE,
AND DIRECTING FILING**

On September 1, 2009, tw telecom of kansas city llc (TWTC) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a waiver of 4 CSR 240-32.050(4)(B) requiring the company to deliver a paper copy of the residential white page telephone directory to households and businesses. TWTC requests a similar waiver to that granted to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, and Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC, in File No. IE-2009-0357. TWTC's request differs, however, in that it requests that its customers call the AT&T Missouri established toll-free number rather than contacting TWTC to receive a paper copy of the directory. TWTC also requests that the Commission establish a procedure so that all CLECs operating in AT&T Missouri's St. Louis, Kansas City, and Springfield MCAs could be granted this same partial waiver of the rule.

The Commission will provide notice of TWTC's application to potentially interested parties and to the public. The Commission will also set dates for the filing of intervention requests and for its Staff to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving the St. Louis and Kansas City metropolitan areas, and to the members of the General Assembly representing those areas.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to every company authorized to operate as an ILEC, CLEC, or IXC in the State of Missouri.
3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than September 15, 2009. Such application shall be filed with:

4. The Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation no later than September 25, 2009
5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
