In 1913, Bell filed an Affidavit of Name Chnage with the Missouri Secretary of State's Office, certifying its change of name to The Southwestern Telegraph and Telephone Company ("Southwestern"). In 1916, through mergers and a name change, Missouri and Southwestern became Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. On 10/12/2001, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Southwestern Bell Texas, Inc. and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. filed a Joint Application for Order Permitting Corporate Restructuring Pursuant to Section 392.300, R.S.Mo., 4 CSR 240-2.060(1), and 4 CSR 240-2.060(8).
