This email is to notify you that we have not received your revised annual report as requested in the previous deficiency email sent to you on 4/22/08, therefore your response is considered PAST DUE.

As stated in that email, the Missouri Public Service Commission's rules within chapter 3 of 4 CSR 240 state that a utility company that receives a notice that deficiencies exist in the information provided in the annual report shall respond to that notice within **20 days** or the utility company is subject to a **penalty of \$100 for each day** that it is late in filing its response to the deficiency.

Please submit an annual report with a completed notarized verification page, including the State and County.

If you are in the process of sending the revision, have already done so or need assistance in the matter, please contact me immediately so that I can notate the information in your file to prevent further action from our General Counsel's office.

You must respond **by June 9th**, in order to prevent your file from being put into the deficiency process by our General Counsel's office.
