EMPIRE'S RESPONSE TO STAFF AND PUBLIC COUNSEL RECOMMENDATIONS AND REQUEST FOR PREHEARING CONFERENCE

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), and, in response to the recommendations filed by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Staff ("Staff") and the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel"), states as follows to the Commission:

- 1. On July 22, 2002, Empire filed its application which initiated this case. On December 10, 2002, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing which directed the Staff to file its memorandum and recommendation in response to the application. On January 10, 2003, the Staff filed its recommendation wherein it stated, among other things, that Empire's application should only be granted if Empire accepts certain conditions identified as (a) (h). On January 14, 2003, the Public Counsel filed its recommendation wherein it also suggested that Empire's application only be approved if Empire agrees to comply with Staff conditions (a) (h).
- 2. Empire has reviewed the Staff and Public Counsel recommendations. Empire is not agreeable to the conditions proposed by Staff and supported by the Public Counsel.
- 3. Accordingly, Empire requests that the Commission issue its order setting a prehearing conference and requiring the filing of a procedural schedule. Such a prehearing hearing conference should provide an opportunity for the parties to pursue settlement discussions

or, in the alternative, ensure the prompt resolution of this matter.

WHEREFORE, Empire prays that the Commission consider Empire's response to the Staff and OPC recommendations and, thereafter, issue its order setting a prehearing conference and requiring the filing of a procedural schedule.
