On June 1, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, Ameren Missouri has 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer. Since this notice is being issued on June 2, Ameren Missouri's answer is due no later than July 2, 2015.

As required by Section 536.067(2)(f), RSMo 2000, the Commission informs the parties that the Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission are found in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240, Chapter 2. In particular, provisions relating to discovery, are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.
