**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On July 8, 2020, the Missouri Public Service Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing on the Complaint of Debbie Feken against Empire District Electric Company. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission ordered briefing and took the case under advisement.

The Commission’s findings of fact will be at least partially based upon exhibits that have been designated as confidential in EFIS. To avoid issuing an order that is largely confidential, the Commission will order the parties to file pleadings identifying specifically which information now designated as confidential in the record they wish to be confidential, for each designated item giving reasons why it should be confidential, in compliance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than August 27, 2020, the parties shall file pleadings in compliance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135, identifying specifically which information now designated as confidential in the record they wish to be confidential. For each item of

information so designated, the parties shall state their reasons why the information should be confidential.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
