**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
AND DIRECTING STATUS REPORT**

On April 19, 2022, Glory Pittsenbarger filed a complaint against The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (Liberty). On July 13, the Commission issued its Order Setting Procedural Schedule, setting an evidentiary hearing for 9:00 a.m. on August 8. On July 29, Staff filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule, explaining that the parties have reached a tentative agreement to settle the case and requesting that this case be suspended while the parties are resolving the complaint.

The Commission will grant Staff's request and direct the parties to file a status report no later than August 29, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule issued on July 13, 2022, is suspended, pending settlement negotiations between the parties.
2. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for August 8, 2022, is removed from the Commission's calendar.

3. The parties will file a joint status report apprising the Commission whether settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement no later than August 29, 2022.

4. This Order shall be effective when issued.
