## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING STATING WHEN IT WILL FILE A RECOMMENDATION IN THIS CASE

On November 13, 2008, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire")<sup>1</sup> filed an application<sup>2</sup> seeking authority to issue and sell up to and including \$250,000,000 principal amount of its First Mortgage Bonds under its existing Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust.<sup>3</sup> The Commission will need a recommendation from its Staff before acting on Empire's application. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to promptly respond to Empire's application and will permit any other interested party to respond. Staff shall indicate in its response when it will be able to file a recommendation in this matter.

The Indenture of Mortgage and Deed of Trust, as amended and supplemented, including thirty-three (33) Supplemental Indentures, constitutes a first mortgage lien on substantially all of the properties presently owned by Empire and contains provisions for subjecting after-acquired property to the lien thereof.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than December 1, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading responding to The Empire District Electric Company's financing application and state in that response when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this case.

2. Any other party that wishes to respond to The Empire District Electric Company's financing application shall do so no later than December 1, 2008.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issue.
