STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant Access One, Inc., (Applicant), a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the service areas of Southwestern Bell Telephone L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri; Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint; CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC; and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel; conditioned upon certain access rate provisions. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo. (2000).)
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3.)

- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission grant the waivers listed in the *Notice of Application*. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392. §§ 392.185, 392.361.5, and 392.420.
- 4. Finally, Staff mentions that a tariff was not submitted with the *Application*. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), the applicant cannot lawfully provide service until tariffs are effective.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Access One, Inc., a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services, conditioned upon the access rate provisions described in the Staff memorandum; grant competitive classification; and a grant waiver of the statutes and regulations listed in the Commission's *Notice of Applications*.
