MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this *Motion for Extension of Time* with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") stating as follows:

1. On November 1, 2013, Mike Layton filed a *Complaint* with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L").

2. On November 4, 2013, the Commission issued its *Order Giving Notice of Contested Case, Directing Answer and Directing Staff Investigation*. Pursuant to that Order, Staff is to file a recommendation on the *Complaint* by no later than December 18, 2013.

3. On December 4, 2013, the Commission issued an *Order* giving KCP&L an extension of time to file an answer to the *Complaint* until January 4, 2014, to allow for continuing settlement discussions.

4. Due to the fact that the parties are in settlement discussions, good cause exists for Staff being granted an extension of time to file its recommendation, so as to not impede a possible settlement between the parties. Staff requests the Commission grant it an extension to file its recommendation until January 14, 2014.

5. Staff contacted the parties in the case, and they do not object to Staff's Motion.

WHEREFORE, Staff files this *Motion for Extension of Time* with which it requests the Commission grant it an extension until January 14, 2014, to file its recommendation.
