**REPLY OF AARP AND THE CONSUMERS COUNCIL OF MISSOURI
TO AMEREN MISSOURI'S RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION
TO NORANDA ET AL'S REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW AND RELIEF**

COMES NOW AARP and the Consumers Council of Missouri (“Consumers Council” or “CCM”), and for its Reply to Ameren Missouri’s Response in Opposition to Noranda et al.’s Request for Expedited Review and Relief, states as follows:

1. AARP and the Consumers Council both support and concur in the statements made in the Missouri Retailers Association Reply to Ameren Missouri’s Response, filed in this rate case yesterday (March 24, 2014).

2. Ameren Missouri is over-earning by a significant amount. Electric consumers deserve a rate reduction. The parties should be allowed to file their recommended procedural schedules on April 1, 2014, and the Commission should take action to expeditiously move this rate case forward, so that all of the utility’s consumers may be afforded just and reasonable rate relief.
