**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO EXTEND DUE
DATE OF SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY**

On May 29, 2014, the Complainants filed a motion asking the Commission to modify the procedural schedule to extend the due date for surrebuttal testimony from June 27, to July 14. So that it will be able to address the motion at its June 11 agenda session, the Commission will establish a shortened response date for anyone wishing to respond to that motion.
