**ORDER ALLOWING FURTHER TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

Issue Date: August 17, 2015

Effective Date: August 17, 2015

The Missouri Public Service Commission is sua sponte granting further time for Staff to file its recommendation.

The recommendation is currently due on August 24, 2015.<sup>1</sup> But that is the date on which any response to Staff’s pending motion for waiver (“motion”)<sup>2</sup> is due.<sup>3</sup> The motion seeks a waiver of the regulation that bars Staff from “advocat[ing] a position beyond reporting the results of its investigation.” The Commission’s ruling on the motion might influence the content of Staff’s recommendation.

Therefore, the Commission will not require a recommendation on the complaint until the Commission makes its ruling on the motion.
