**ORDER SETTING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE**

The Commission will convene a pre-hearing conference as suggested by the parties.<sup>1</sup> The first part of the conference shall be on the record with the regulatory law judge assigned to this case (“RLJ”) in attendance. The Commission will take up the *Motion to Continue (4 CSR 240-2.117(D))*,<sup>2</sup> and the parties shall be prepared to discuss the motion for summary determination to which it relates.<sup>3</sup> The second part of the conference shall be off the record and out of the RLJ’s presence. Staff shall co-ordinate a joint proposed procedural schedule, and the parties may discuss related matters. Before the end of the day, Staff shall file the joint proposed procedural schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission will convene a pre-hearing conference on October 6, 2015, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
