**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR
SUMMARY DETERMINATION**

On February 5, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed a motion for summary determination of its complaint against KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO). Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.117(1)(C) provides that responses to a motion for summary determination are to be filed not more than thirty days after such a motion is served. Thirty days after February 5 is March 6, which is a Sunday. Therefore, any responses to Staff's motion for summary determination are to be filed no later than Monday, March 7.
