ORDER SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On February 1, 2016, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) and 32 other individual customers of Ameren Missouri filed a complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, asking that Ameren Missouri's rate structure be redesigned to reduce rates for Noranda Aluminum, Inc. Ameren Missouri filed a timely answer on February 9. The Commission now must determine how to proceed to consider the complaint.

To assist in that determination, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference at which the parties may discuss the establishment of a procedural schedule. The parties may also discuss discovery questions and any other matters that may arise.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A procedural conference is scheduled for March 7, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 310. This building meets accessibility standards required by the
