ORDER REGARDING DISCOVERY FILINGS

William L. Gehrs, Jr., filed a request for discovery. The request for discovery cites Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.090:

Discovery may be obtained by the same means and under the same conditions as in civil actions in the circuit court. Sanctions for abuse of the discovery process or failure to comply with commission orders regarding discovery shall be the same as those provided for in the rules of civil procedure. [²]

The means and conditions for obtaining discovery in civil actions in the circuit court require serving discovery requests on other parties, filing a certificate of service, and not filing the discovery requests:

Service. Copies of the interrogatories shall be served on all parties not in default. . . . In addition to the information normally in a certificate of service, the certificate of service shall also state:

- (A) The name of each party who is to respond to the interrogatories;
- (B) The number of the set of interrogatories,
- (C) The format of the electronic copy and the medium used to transmit the electronic copy to the responding party.

At the time of service, a certificate of service, but not the [discovery requests], shall be filed [.3]

The Commission will retain the requests for discovery to give context to this order, but will not accept any other discovery requests for filing, except in the context of enforcing discovery.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission will retain the requests for discovery and will reject any other discovery requests, except in the context of enforcing discovery.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
