On May 28, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) filed an application and motion for expedited treatment seeking a ruling from the Commission regarding whether the Commission has jurisdiction over KCP&L's plan to transfer 32 unused wind turbine generators and certain property rights. KCP&L indicates it plans to complete the transfer before the end of June and therefore requests the Commission act on its application expeditiously. The Commission's Staff responded to KCP&L's application and motion on June 4. Staff contends the Commission has jurisdiction over the transaction and urges the Commission to deny KCP&L's application and instead order the company to file an application for authority to complete the transaction.

Before acting on KCP&L's application, the Commission would like to obtain more information from the parties. For that purpose, the Commission will schedule an on-the-record discussion before its June 16, 2010 agenda session. The parties should be prepared to discuss both the question of the Commission's jurisdiction, and to the extent possible, the merits of KCP&L's plan to transfer the property.
