**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR REHEARING**

**Syllabus:** This order denies Sierra Club and Concerned Citizens of Platte County's motion for rehearing.

On July 28, 2005, the Commission issued its Report and Order. That Report and Order approved KCPL's experimental regulatory plan. On August 5, Sierra Club and Concerned Citizens of Platte County filed a Motion for Rehearing.<sup>1</sup>

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." The Commission finds that Sierra Club and Concerned Citizens of Platte County have failed to establish sufficient reason to grant their motion. The Commission will deny it.

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<sup>1</sup> KCPL responded on August 10. In that response, KCPL referred to an attempt another individual made to ask for rehearing. Because that individual failed to follow the Commission's procedural rules, the Commission rejected and returned that application. The Commission, therefore, has no other applications for rehearing before it.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Sierra Club and Concerned Citizens of Platte County's Motion for Rehearing is denied.
2. That this order shall become effective on August 23, 2005.
