ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On January 24, 2006, the Commission issued an order approving a stipulation and agreement, which facilitated Girardeau Stevedores Contractors to change its electric supplier from SEMO Electric Cooperative to Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. The order required the change to take effect in no less than 30 and no more than 60 days from the date of the order. On March 31, 2006, AmerenUE filed a request for an extension of time, until June 30, 2006, to complete the transfer.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) requires that responsive pleadings be filed within ten days. Ten days have expired since AmerenUE filed its request. No party has filed a pleading in opposition to the request. The Commission finds that the request is reasonable and will grant the extension.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's request for an extension of time, until June 30, 2006, to complete the transfer of the electric supplier of Girardeau Stevedores Contractors is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on April 18, 2006.
