ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET FILED IN COMPLIANCE
WITH COMMISSION'S ORDER

This order approves the tariff sheet filed in compliance with a Commission order by Kansas City Power & Light Company.

On April 4, 2006, KCPL submitted a proposed tariff sheet. KCPL filed a substitute sheet on April 13, 2006. The proposed tariff sheet lists both the special contract approved in EO-2006-0192 and the special contract approved in EO-2006-0193. The identity of the customers and the specific terms of the special contracts are designated as highly confidential and filed under seal. KCPL's tariff sheet has a proposed effective date of May 5, 2006.

On April 28, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a recommendation. Staff states that it has reviewed Tariff No. JE-2006-0755 and is of the opinion that it is in compliance with the Commission's order. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheet to become effective on May 5, 2006.

The Commission has reviewed KCPL's tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation. Based on these filings, the Commission finds that the tariff sheet shall be approved, as substituted, as ordered below.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Tariff No. JE-2006-0755, submitted on April 4, 2006, and substituted on April 13, 2006, is hereby approved for electric service rendered on or after May 5, 2006.
