ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE WAIVER REQUESTS

On February 8, 2007, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement regarding the 2005 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. The approved stipulation and agreement established a timeline that requires AmerenUE to take certain steps leading up to the filing of its next IRP in February 2008. That timeline requires AmerenUE to file a request for waiver of Commission rules for Electric Utility Resource Planning by April 5, 2007. On April 2, AmerenUE filed a motion requesting additional time to file its request for waivers.

AmerenUE's motion explains that it has circulated a draft of its proposed waiver requests to the other parties. But, because of the press of other matters, chiefly AmerenUE's recently concluded rate-case hearing, not all the parties have had time to comment on the proposed waivers. For that reason, AmerenUE requests that it be allowed an additional two weeks, until April 19, to file its waiver requests.

AmerenUE's motion represents that the other parties to the stipulation and agreement do not object to the request for additional time.

Based on AmerenUE's unopposed motion, the Commission will grant AmerenUE's request for additional time to file its waiver requests.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Motion for Additional Time to File Waiver Requests is granted.
2. Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE shall file its waiver requests no later than April 19, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on April 3, 2007.
