ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On December 28, 2005, Sierra Club, Missouri Coalition for the Environment, and Missouri Nuclear Weapons Education Fund, operating as Mid-Missouri Peaceworks, filed a joint application to intervene. At the prehearing conference held on January 3, 2006, the presiding officer granted the applications to intervene of Sierra Club and Missouri Coalition for the Environment.

Although its application to intervene indicates that Peaceworks is a Missouri nonprofit corporation, at the conference, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, expressed some concern about the legal status of Peaceworks and whether that entity should be required to comply with the Commission's rule requiring an unincorporated association to file a list of its members at the time it applies to intervene. The presiding officer deferred ruling on Peaceworks' application to intervene at that time to allow AmerenUE until January 7 to file a written objection to Peaceworks' application to intervene if it decided to do so.

AmerenUE has not filed an objection to Peaceworks' application to intervene and that application is not opposed by any other party. The Commission finds that Peaceworks has an interest that is different than that of the general public and that its interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that Peaceworks' proposed intervention will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Application to Intervene of the Missouri Nuclear Weapons Education Fund, operating as Mid-Missouri Peaceworks, is granted.

2. That this order shall become effective on January 9, 2006.
