### **ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE OUT OF TIME**

On June 22, 2006,<sup>1</sup> the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the Commission establish a case, provide notice, set an intervention deadline and schedule an early prehearing conference for the purpose of determining whether to adopt the Fuel Sources Standard established in Section 1251 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 ("EPAAct"). The Commission granted Staff's motion on June 23.

On August 17, the Commission issued an order directing filing of responses to a prepared list of questions from Staff no later than September 15. The deadline was set, per Staff's request, to give all parties adequate time to review the responses prior to the technical conference scheduled for September 22.

On September 20, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") filed its response to the August 17 order, and filed a motion for leave to file its responses out of time. OPC states that it supports the positions take by other parties in response to the list of questions, and; consequently, no party will prejudiced by its delayed response.
