**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

On July 5, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed public versions of information in compliance with the Commission's integrated resource planning (IRP) reporting requirements. Concurrently with the information, KCPL filed the public version of its application for extensions of time and waivers concerning certain of the requirements. KCPL also filed a motion for a protective order.

In support of its motion, KCPL states that issuance of a protective order will permit it to expeditiously file the highly confidential versions of its IRP reporting requirements and application. KCPL states that none of the information for which a claim of confidentiality is made can be found in any format in any other public document.

The Commission finds that KCPL's motion substantially complies with 4 CSR 240-2.085 and shall be granted. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential and proprietary information, and the issuance of protective orders has helped to minimize disputes in past cases. The Commission will adopt its standard protective order for this case.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Motion for Protective Order is granted, and the protective order attached to this order as Attachment A is adopted for this case.
2. This order shall become effective on July 13, 2006.
