#### **ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS**

Effective Date: September 7, 2006

On July 27, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission opened this case directing the Staff of the Commission to begin a formal investigation of Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE and any other regulated utilities whose activities have an impact on storm restoration efforts concerning the effectiveness of its storm preparation and restoration efforts in Eastern Missouri. The Commission established August 7, 2006, as the deadline for interested parties to intervene. On August 7, 2006, the City of Creve Coeur, Missouri, filed an application to intervene. On August 8, 2006, the City of Ferguson, Missouri, filed an application to intervene.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 governs intervention before the Commission. That rule states that the Commission may allow a party to intervene if the proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the applications, and considering no objections have been made to the City or Creve Coeur or the City of Ferguson's applications to intervene, the Commission finds that the proposed interveners either have an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or that granting the proposed interventions would serve the public interest. Therefore, the Commission will grant the City of Creve Coeur and the City of Ferguson's applications to intervene.

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The application to intervene filed by the City of Creve Coeur, is granted.
- 2. The application to intervene filed by the City of Ferguson, is granted.
- 3. This order shall become effective on September 7, 2006.
