## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS

On February 5, 2007, Aquila Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P, filed its Utility Resource Filing as required by 4 CSR 240-22. This filing is also sometimes known as an integrated resource plan, or IRP. The Commission gave notice of this filing, allowing potential parties until February 27 to request intervention.

Sedalia Industrial Energy Users Association (SIEUA), Kansas City Power & Light Company, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the City of St. Joseph, Missouri, and Dogwood Energy, LLC, applied for intervention. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. Aquila opposes Dogwood Energy's intervention, and the Commission will address Dogwood Energy's motion in a separate order. No party timely responded to the remaining applications to intervene. Therefore, the Commission will take them up unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications,

the Commission finds that the applicants meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the unopposed applications, and will allow the applicants to intervene.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The applications to intervene of Sedalia Industrial Energy Users Association (SIEUA), Kansas City Power & Light Company, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri are granted, and those applicants are now parties to this case.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on March 14, 2007.
