## ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO APPEAR AT AGENDA MEETING AND DIRECTING PARTIES TO FILE SUGGESTIONS ON NOTICE TO BE GIVEN TO PURCHASERS

On October 12, 2005, the Commission conducted a hearing on WST, Inc.'s application requesting that the Commission grant a variance from Kansas City Power & Light Company's tariff to allow it to complete a redevelopment project using a master electric meter. WST has asked the Commission to rule on its application by October 19.

The Commission will consider an order regarding WST's application at its agenda meeting on October 18. In order to facilitate its discussion of that order, the Commission will direct counsel for the parties to appear at the agenda meeting and to be prepared to answer questions from the Commissioners regarding the application. If counsel want to bring their clients with them to the agenda session, they are encouraged to do so.

In addition, the Commission is concerned that purchasers of the condominium units are made aware that under WST's proposal they would be purchasing their electricity from the condominium owners association, not from KCPL, and that they would not receive the consumer protections that they would receive as KCPL customers. The parties will be

directed to file their suggestions regarding the language of an appropriate notice to be given to the purchasers.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That counsel for the parties are directed to appear at the Commission's agenda meeting on October 18, 2005, to answer questions from the Commission.
- 2. That the parties shall file written suggestions regarding the language of an appropriate notice to be given to purchasers of condominium units no later than 1:00 p.m. on October 17, 2005.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on October 13, 2005.
