STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEET

- 1. By Report and Order issued October 19, 2005 and made effective October 28, 2005, the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (Commission), at the request of WST, Inc., granted Kansas City Power & Light Company a variance from its tariff to allow Kansas City Power & Light Company to continue to provide master metered electrical service to the newly renovated WallStreet Tower Condominiums building located at 1101 Walnut Street, Kansas City, Missouri, when the service will be used to supply electricity to individual condominium units. 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends the Missouri Public Service Commission issue an Order approving the proposed tariff sheet, as filed on January 24, 2006 to become effective March 8, 2006, or allow the sheet to become effective by operation of law.
