ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE FROM VARIANCE COMMITTEE

On January 29, 2015, reStart Housing Services, Inc., filed an application requesting a variance from the individual electric metering requirement found in the Commission's rules and in the tariffs of Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L). The Commission has received responses to that application from KCP&L and from the Staff of the Commission. However, Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.050(5) creates a variance committee to consider all variance requests and to make a recommendation about such requests to the Commission. Before acting on reStart Housing's request for variance, the Commission will direct the variance committee to file a recommendation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The variance committee established pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.050(5) shall file a recommendation regarding reStart Housing Services, Inc.'s Application for Variance no later than February 18, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
