ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO OPEN AN INVESTIGATION, SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE AND DIRECTING THE FILING OF A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 20, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a motion to open an investigation into tariff sheets filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri to implement its Voluntary Green Program/Pure Power Program. The tariff sheets were filed in relation to a Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed in ER-2012-0166. The tariff sheets bear an effective date of May 1, 2013. The Commission will grant Staff's motion, set a procedural conference and direct the filing of a proposed procedural schedule.

- 1. The Staff of the Public Service commission's motion to open an investigation is granted.
