## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STATUS REPORT AND RE-SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 9, 2008 JACOR Contracting, Inc., ("JACOR"), filed a complaint with the Commission against NuVox Communications of Missouri, Inc. ("NuVox") and Southwestern Bell Communications Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri"). On October 21, AT&T Missouri filed a request for mediation, indicating its willingness to enter into third-party mediation. That filing tolled the procedural order issued on October 9, 2008, which set the schedule for the filing of the Respondents' answers and the Staff's investigation report.

A mediation session was scheduled for January 20, 2009. That date has passed and the Commission will order the parties to file a status report indicating if a settlement was reached or if settlement negotiations are in progress. If no settlement has been

reached the procedural schedule for the filing of Respondents' answers and Staff's investigation report will be resumed.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than January 26, 2009, the parties shall jointly file a status report as described in the body of this order.

2. If the parties have not reached a settlement in this matter, the procedural schedule shall resume as follows:

a.) NuVox Communications of Missouri, Inc. shall, no later than February 13, 2009, file a response to this complaint;

b.) Southwestern Bell Communications Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri shall, no later than February 13, 2009, file a response to this complaint; and,

c.) The Staff of the Commission shall file, no later than February 23, 2009, a report of its investigation in this matter.

d.) This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
