## NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

Issue Date: January 13, 2016

On January 8, 2016, Triggerfish Corporation filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol service. Triggerfish Corporation's application was not complete in that the affidavit attached to the application failed to provide the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide VoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo. In addition, the Application's Certificate of Service listed a delivery date of October 30, 2015, however the application was not filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission until January 8, 2016.

Triggerfish's filing is deficient and the Commission will not take action on this application until this deficiency is corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until February 2, 2016, to allow Triggerfish Corporation to correct the

deficiency. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
