ORDER REJECTING FILING

On January 8, 2016, Triggerfish Corporation filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol (“IVoIP”) service with the Missouri Public Service Commission indicating its intention to offer and provide IVoIP services in the State of Missouri.

The application filed with the Commission was not sufficient in that the attached affidavit failed to identify the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide IVoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo. The Application’s Certificate of Service listed a delivery date of October 30, 2015, however the application was not filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission until January 8, 2016.

On January 13, 2016, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiencies by February 2, 2016. No response was filed. Thus, the application will be rejected by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application filed by Triggerfish Corporation on January 8, 2016, is rejected.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
