## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On April 23, 2008, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking authority to issue up to \$314 million aggregate principal amount of additional long-term indebtedness. Due to volatile and changing financial markets, AmerenUE asks the Commission to issue an order approving its request by May 31, 2008. In order for the Commission to issue an order approving this application by May 31, Staff will need to file its recommendation no later than May 23.

The Commission will, therefore, order Staff to file its recommendation by May 23. If, however, Staff is unable to properly review AmerenUE's application by that date, it can request more time.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file, no later than May 23, 2008, its recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's application for authority to issue and sell additional long-term indebtedness.
