**ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On July 3, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") asked the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for a variance from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-10.030(28)(C), relating to the time for testing electric service watt-hour meters. The Commission previously granted Ameren Missouri a variance from the requirement to periodically test every meter by giving approval to use certain standardized statistical sampling techniques with regard to the testing of single phase meters. Ameren Missouri now requests that the Commission extend that variance to include two phase, three wire, 120/208V meters. The Commission will order its Staff to file a recommendation responding to the variance request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a Staff Recommendation no later than August 6, 2012.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
