ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE

On March 10, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed an application requesting a variance from the annual surveillance filing requirement of the Commission's Demand-Side Programs Investment Mechanism rule as set forth in 4 CSR 240-20.0939(9). The rule would require GMO to file its annual DSIM surveillance report on March 13 along with its fuel cost adjustment mechanism surveillance report. GMO will file its fuel cost adjustment mechanism surveillance report on March 13, but asks to be allowed until April 7 to file its DSIM surveillance report.

Before acting on GMO's request for variance, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond to that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall respond to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Application for Variance no later than 1:00 p.m. on March 12, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
