**ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT REGARDING  
CONFIDENTIALITY OF JOINT REQUEST**

On October 14, 2015, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Noranda Aluminum, Inc. filed a joint request seeking variances from several tariff and regulatory requirements. The joint request was filed as highly confidential in its entirety. The Commission has questions about the appropriateness of treating the joint request as entirely highly confidential, and the Commission will schedule an oral argument to hear from counsel for the parties on that question.

The oral argument will address only the question of confidentiality and will not address the merits of the joint request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. An oral argument is scheduled for October 28, 2015, immediately following the conclusion of the Commission's Agenda Meeting. The oral argument will take place in the agenda room and will be on the record, but will be treated as highly confidential and will not be webcast. Counsel for the parties may appear by telephone if they wish, but anyone wishing to appear by phone shall so inform the presiding officer no later than October 27 so that arrangements can be made.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
