The oral argument will take place in the agenda room and will be on the record, but will be treated as highly confidential and will not be webcast. Counsel for the parties may appear by telephone if they wish, but anyone wishing to appear by phone shall so inform the presiding officer no later than October 27 so that arrangements can be made.
