## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND SETTING DATE FOR FILING

Issue Date: August 16, 2017

Effective Date: August 16, 2017

The Commission is granting the applications to intervene, setting a date for responses to the application for waivers, and setting a date for any response to the recommendation of the Commission's staff ("Staff").

On August 2,<sup>1</sup> Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed the application<sup>2</sup> asking the Commission to waive certain filings related to Ameren Missouri's Integrated Resource Plan ("application for waivers"). The application for waivers also asked the Commission for a ruling on the merits by September 1.

The Commission issued its order<sup>3</sup> shortening the time for filing an application to intervene.<sup>4</sup> The Commission received applications to intervene from the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers,<sup>5</sup> the Missouri Division of Energy ("DoE"),<sup>6</sup> and Midwest Energy Consumers Group.<sup>7</sup> Ameren Missouri filed a response.<sup>8</sup> DoE filed a reply.<sup>9</sup>

The standard for intervention is that:

The commission may grant a motion to intervene . . . if—

(A) The proposed intervenor . . . has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or

(B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. [<sup>10</sup>]

Each applicant for intervention has met that standard, so the Commission will grant each application to intervene.

The Commission will also set a date for any response to the application for waivers.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The following are granted:

- a. The *Application to Intervene of Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers*;
- b. The *Missouri Division of Energy's Motion to Intervene*; and
- c. The *Application to Intervene of the Midwest Energy Consumers Group*.

2. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the Missouri Division of Energy, and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (“intervenors”) shall be parties to this case.

3. No later than August 23, 2017, any response from any intervenor or the Office of the Public Counsel to the application for waivers shall be filed.


