**NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY**

Issue Date: January 7, 2020

On January 3, 2020, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri), filed an application seeking variance from certain provisions of Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-20.065, concerning net metering applications. Those who intend to file an application to the Commission are required to file a notice with the Commission's secretary a minimum of 60 days prior to filing an application, pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-4.017. Commission records do not include such a notice, nor does Ameren Missouri's application seek a waiver of the 60-day requirement, as allowed by 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1)(D). In addition, Ameren Missouri's application, filed on January 3, 2020, does not comply with the requirements of 20 CSR 4240-2.060(1), governing applications.

The Commission will not take action on this application until these deficiencies are corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until February 7, 2020, to allow Ameren Missouri to correct the deficiencies. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
