ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On June 23, 2020, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) filed an application seeking variance from certain provisions of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(A), concerning information to be reported in Ameren Missouri's Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report.

On July 6, 2020, Sierra Club filed an application to intervene. Sierra Club's application contends its interests are different from the general public and may be adversely affected by a final order in this case. Sierra Club contends allowing Sierra Club to intervene will serve the public interest, noting that Sierra Club submitted comments on Ameren Missouri's 2019 RES compliance report in File No. EO-2020-0328. More than 10 days have passed since Sierra Club applied to intervene; no party has objected to Sierra Club's application.

The Commission will grant Sierra Club's application to intervene based on a determination that intervention will serve the public interest.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Sierra Club's application to intervene is granted.
