On March 10, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a request asking the Commission to grant it a variance from 20 CSR 4240-22.080(1)(C). Specifically, Ameren Missouri seeks to delay its next required triennial compliance filing from April 1, 2023, until October 1, 2023. Ameren Missouri also request a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1),

The Commission will provide notice to potentially interested parties, and will establish an intervention deadline. The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation about Ameren Missouri's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties to Ameren Missouri's most recent integrated resource plan triennial compliance filing, EO-2021-0021.
2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than March 31, 2022.
3. Staff shall file its recommendation about Ameren Missouri's request no later than April 11, 2022.

4. This order is effective when issued.
