## OBJECTION TO STIPULATION OF MIDWEST ENERGY CONSUMERS GROUP

COMES NOW the Midwest Energy Consumer's Group, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.115(2), and for its Objection to Stipulation, states as follows:

1. On October 12, 2016, Joint Applicants and Staff filed its Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement in this docket ("Staff Stipulation"). On October 18, 2016, MECG filed its Objection to that Stipulation. On October 26, 2016, Joint Applicants filed a separate Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement with the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC Stipulation").

2. The OPC Stipulation expressly relies upon the previously objected-to Staff Stipulation. Since the OPC stipulation is built upon the Staff Stipulation, MEGC is uncertain whether a separate objection to the OPC stipulation is necessary. Nevertheless, through this pleading, MECG states its objection to the October 26, 2016, Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
