ORDER GRANTING STAFF MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM ORDER

On February 14, 2013¹, Entergy Arkansas, Inc. (“EAI”), Mid South TransCo LLC (Mid South TransCo”), Transmission Company Arkansas, LLC (“TC Arkansas”) and ITC Midsouth LLC (“ITC Midsouth”) (“Joint Applicants”), filed a Joint Application. Entergy Corporation (“Entergy”) wishes to transfer EAI’s transmission assets to a subsidiary of ITC Holdings Corp.; namely, TC Arkansas. The Commission subsequently set the case for hearing.

On April 19, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Relief from Order. Staff states that because the Commission has set the case for hearing, Staff should be relieved of its obligation to file a Recommendation on May 15.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) permits parties ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered. The Commission issued no order to the contrary, ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected.


The Commission finds Staff’s motion reasonable, and will grant it.
