On July 16, 2009, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel the VoIP Service Registration of DIECA Communications Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company. On July 21, 2009, Covad filed a Motion for Additional Time requesting an extension through August 7 to respond to Staff's request for cancellation. Covad stated it believes Staff's motion to cancel is based on a misunderstanding of the application for the discontinuance of service, pleadings, and notices Covad submitted to the Federal Communications Commission.

The Commission will grant Covad's request for additional time to respond to Staff's motion and responses shall be filed as set out below.

1. Any responses to Staff's Motion to Cancel VoIP Registration shall be filed no later than August 7, 2009.
