PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel and for its Response to Order Granting Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule states as follows:

- 1. On April 11, 2012, over the objections of Public Counsel and all the other representatives of GMO's customers (who identified themselves as the Signatories for the purpose of their joint filing), the Commission granted GMO's motion to modify the procedural schedule. In its order, the Commission noted that it was "sensitive to the scheduling difficulties of all parties," and might favorably consider additional motions to modify the procedural schedule.
- 2. In addition to the substantive reasons the Signatories explained in their joint filing in opposition to the schedule changes, the undersigned has a scheduling conflict with the new hearing dates. In March, the undersigned accepted an invitation to speak at a National Governors' Association meeting on energy policy in Washington D.C. being held on May 30 and 31. Accordingly, Public Counsel will be requesting a change in the currently-scheduled hearing dates.
- 3. While settlement discussions may be proceeding in this case and may result in settlement of some or all issues among some or all parties, it is unclear what the scope of any

agreement might be or when it might be filed. Accordingly, it is premature to request specific alternate hearing dates, but since the scheduling of the hearing in this case may impact additional cases, Public Counsel wanted to inform the Commission and the parties of this conflict.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel respectfully submits this Response to Order Granting Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule.
