### ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

A prehearing conference was held September 20, 2018, beginning at 10:00 a.m. Complainant failed to appear in person or by telephone, and did not contact the Commission prior to the prehearing conference to request a continuance. A show cause order was issued ordering Complainant to show cause why his complaint should not be dismissed.

Complainant filed a response with the Commission explaining why he felt his complaint should not be dismissed, but failed to explain why he failed to appear at the prehearing. Even so, Complainant has demonstrated his desire to pursue the complaint.

The Commission will schedule another prehearing conference at which the parties may discuss the establishment of a procedural schedule. Complainant shall

attend the prehearing conference either in person or by telephone so that an evidentiary hearing date is scheduled when he is available to attend.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference to be held on November 8, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. Failure to appear at the conference without being excused may result in a default being issued in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090(5).
- 2. The prehearing conference will convene in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. The building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the conference or hearing shall contact the Commission, not later than the day before the conference. Any party may participate in the prehearing conference by telephone by dialing (573) 526-5622 or (866) 630-9348 at the start time of the conference.
