NOTICE OF FORMAL COMPLAINT AND ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PRELIMINARY REPORT

On June 22, 2020, Missouri Landowners Alliance and Gary Mareschal filed the attached complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC, Invenergy Transmission LLC, and Invenergy Investment Company (Respondents). Under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(8), Respondents have thirty days from the date of this notice to satisfy or answer the complaint. A copy of the answer or response shall also be served upon complainants at the address provided in the complaint. In accordance with the Commission's procedural rules, the Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a preliminary report stating when it anticipates being able to file a full report detailing its findings and recommendations.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC, Invenergy Transmission LLC, and Invenergy Investment Company shall file a response to the complaint no later than July 23, 2020.
