**ORDER DIRECTING ADDITIONAL NOTICE**

On April 4, 2007, Great Plains Energy Incorporated, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and Aquila, Inc., filed a joint application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. The applicants requested authority for a series of transactions whereby Aquila will become a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of Great Plains Energy.

On April 9, 2007, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice and Order Directing Filing in which it directed the parties to advise the Commission no later than April 19, 2007, as to whether individual customer notice was needed in this matter. The only response was filed by the Commission Staff. Staff recommends that individual customer notice be given because of the request for certain ratemaking treatment. In addition, Staff recommends that local public hearings be held in this matter.

The Commission finds that written notice of this application should be sent to the each customer giving customers an opportunity to file comments addressing whether or not the proposed transfer is in the public interest. The customer notice should direct customers to file any comments with the Secretary of the Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City,

Missouri 65102, or on the Commission's website at: [www.psc.mo.gov](http://www.psc.mo.gov). Customers should reference Case No. EM-2007-0374 and should file their comments within 30 days of issuance of the notice. The customer notice should also provide the address for the Office of the Public Counsel, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

If notice of this application has already been sent to Aquila's Missouri residential customers, then a copy of the prior customer notice may satisfy this customer notice requirement, upon Commission approval. Aquila may file a copy of a prior customer notice as directed below and request approval of the notice in lieu of issuing a new notice to its customers. Notice by bill insert or separate mailing are both acceptable methods of customer notice.

The Commission shall address the need for local public hearings along with any order setting a procedural schedule in this matter.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Aquila, Inc., shall issue a notice to its customers no later than its next billing cycle. This notice shall inform the affected customers of this application and give sufficient notice to allow the affected customers an opportunity to address whether or not the proposed transfer of assets is in the public interest. The notice shall direct customers to file any comments with the Secretary of the Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102-0360, or at the Commission's website: [www.psc.mo.gov](http://www.psc.mo.gov), within 30 days of issuance of the notice. If notice has already been sent to the affected customers, a copy of the prior notice must be submitted to the Commission for approval no later than May 4, 2007.

2. Aquila, Inc., shall file a copy of the written customer notice indicating when the notice is scheduled to be issued and the manner in which the customer notice will be served.

3. This order shall become effective on April 24, 2007.
